Chris Dransfield RMS Roads and Maritime Project Manager WEST GOSFORD INTERSECTION

Chris formed his address with a presentation slideshow of the works so far on the intersection. Late June was the projection for the left hand turn lane towards Kariong from Brisbane Water Drive to be in place weather permitting. 70,000 vehicle movements a day had been recorded through the old intersection with the RMS taking up option 5 of the plans that were brought before the community when consultation was taking place in 2012. The size of the finished intersection will be that of a Soccer Field – the largest planned intersection in NSW. Chris finished the conversation, answering question from the members regarding the timing allowed for pedestrians to cross at the Kulara Street intersection Brisbane Water Drive, and solving the issue of nuisance flooding. Chris and Eden were thanked by the members and decided to stay for a light supper.

Cream of mushroom soup

Preparation: 15 minutes Serves: 4 Cooking 28 minutes

60g butter
2 medium leeks, trimmed,
halved & thinly sliced
2 garlic cloves, crushed
300g flat mushrooms, diced
300g cup mushrooms, diced
1/3cup plain flour
4 cups chicken stock
2/3cup cream
1/3cup chopped flat-leaf parsley
salt & ground black pepper, to taste
toasted bread, to serve



- Melt butter in a large saucepan over medium-high heat until butter begins to foam. Add leeks & garlic & cook, stirring often, for 3-4 minutes or until soft.
- Add mushrooms & cook, stirring occasionally, for 10 minutes or until mushrooms are tender. Add flour & cook, stirring constantly, for 2 minutes.
- Gradually add stock, stirring constantly. Bring to the boil, stirring constantly, over high heat. Reduce heat to medium-low & cook, stirring occasionally, for 10 minutes.
- Remove from heat & process to desired consistency. Stir in cream & parsley. Heat soup over medium-low heat, without boiling, until hot. Season with salt & pepper & serve with toasted bread.

This soup was included with our light supper and enjoyed by all.
