Guest Speaker – Justin Murphy From REMONDIS Australia Pty Ltd Waste Solutions (Garbage and Recycling)

Thiess services was doing the waste services and has now been taken over by Remondis. They are located up at Somersby, with about 70 trucks and 100 staff. 280000 Bin collections in both Wyong and Gosford. They have a problem with contamination of about 8%, and they would like to reduce that by people putting the right waste in the right bin. About 40000 tones of aluminum was saved and recycled last year. Australia is the second worst nation in the world for their waste per capita, with the US being first. 40% of waste in the red bin is food waste that can go into compost. Other councils can operate their recycling in different ways, with their food waste being sorted out at a treatment plant. Most landfill sites have technology to harvest methane. Australia is producing enough rubbish to fill Victoria 10cm high in 1 year. Take 3 campaign of taking 3 pieces of rubbish every time you visit a park or a beach. Each property is entitled to 6 kerb side collections each year, which can be booked online or over the phone.
